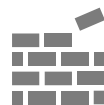

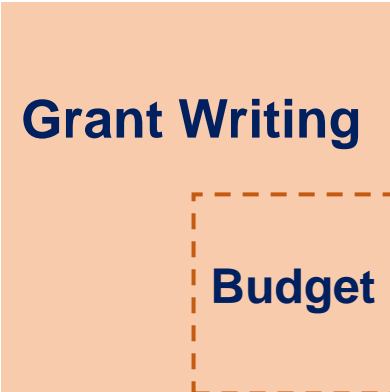
The Impact Fund is part of the Australian Volunteers Program which is funded by the Australian Government through the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade (DFAT).

Activities

Set out the wider context and problem which your project aims to address.

Outline a summary of your project, how it will address the problem, and high level details including the target group, location, number of participants/facilitators, etc.

The positive impacts to your beneficiaries. Frame as increases or decreases in skills, behaviour, conditions, etc. Consider short, medium and long term.

Map out a plan of the project by each activity and note how these are connected to outcomes.

- **Engagement:** How has your target community been engaged and factored into the design, delivery and feedback loop of the project?
- **Inclusion:** How does your project promote gender equality, women's rights, disability inclusion, LGBTIQ+ inclusion, and or indigenous inclusion?

Promoting gender equality, diversity and inclusion is a program value and priority.

Climate Focus & Outcomes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Problem statement and context• Outline positive outcomes to beneficiaries• Clearly address climate action	30%
Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Map out a project plan• Connect to outcomes	20%
Engagement & Inclusion	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Factor in your target community• Demonstrate promotion of inclusion and diversity	20%
Risk	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Show understanding of risks• Outline a plan to manage risks	10%
Sustainability	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Positive impacts beyond the project lifespan	10%
Budget	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Detail and link to activities	10%



Tips

- 1 Give yourself plenty of time to write and submit the application. Aim to submit before the closing day to mitigate unexpected disruptions (like power or internet outages).
- 2 Read the questions in the Application Form carefully.
- 3 Be specific and provide detail.
- 4 Use the resources available. There is plenty of guidance to support you.
- 5 Ask questions. Contact the Impact Fund team, or your In-Country Team for queries or if you encounter any issues.

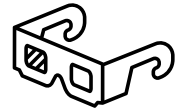

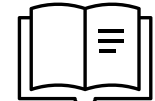
